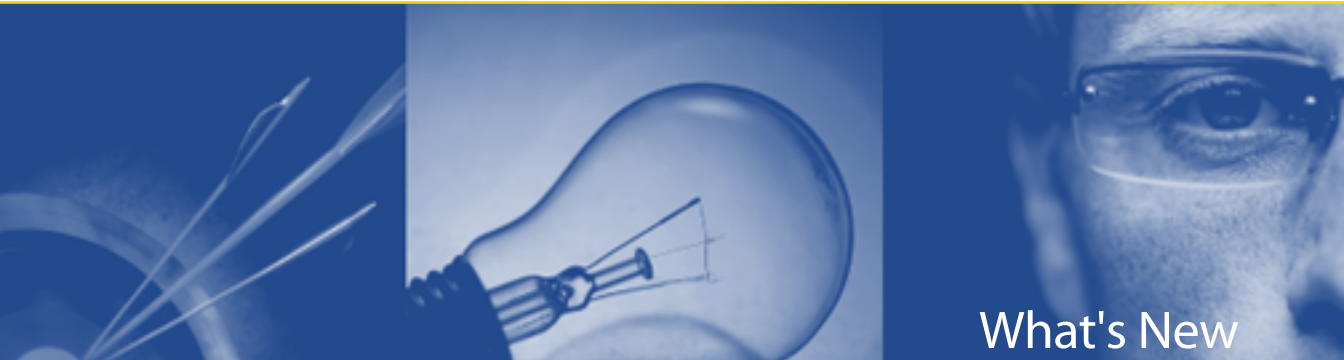

Windows Server 2008 Support

Auditing and object protection capabilities are now extended to Windows Server 2008 domain controllers.

Auto-Import of Missing Data for Reports

All Active Directory and ADAM reports fully support automatic extraction of audit data from InTrust repositories if this data is missing from the audit database.

Inheritance of Protection Settings

If you are configuring protection for an Active Directory or ADAM container, you can choose to apply the protection settings to the child objects. The following options are available:

- Protect this object only
- Protect child objects only
- Protect this object and all child objects

More Detailed ARS Activity Reporting

For Active Directory changes performed using Quest ActiveRoles Server (ARS), the "All activity within and outside of ActiveRoles Server" report now shows the particular user who made the change, instead of just saying that the change was made with ActiveRoles Server.
