This document describes the new features and enhancements of Quest Site Administrator for SharePoint.

New features in Site Administrator for SharePoint 3.6:

Information Portal Settings

Site Administrator Information Portal has the settings page which allows you to grant additional users rights to view all enterprise and site reports, and set the top number of the content databases and web applications to be displayed in the Information Portal reports.
