



Title: Toad® 9.x For Oracle For DBAs

Description: This class is based on the Toad for DBAs module. It focuses on day-to-day activities from an administrator's perspective. Learn how to predict tablespace growth, grant and change user permissions, monitor user sessions, perform database health checks and determine the input/output of tablespace and data files. Hands-on activities, guided walk-throughs, use-case scenarios and best practices are used to reinforce learning.

Audience: Oracle DBAs using Toad 9.x for Oracle or Quest Central for Oracle.

Prerequisites: Students are strongly encouraged to complete the Toad 9.x Introduction course prior to attending this course.

Objectives: Upon completion of this training, the student should be able to:

- Predict tablespace growth
- Grant and modify user privileges
- Perform database health checks
- Monitor users' current sessions
- Determine input/output of tablespace and data files

Format: This 3-hour class, including hands-on activities, is offered as:

- a public, web-based class taught via the Quest virtual classroom.
- a private, web-based class taught via the Quest virtual classroom for up to 8 students.

Note: This course contains material that is also presented in the Quest Central for Oracle class. Students that have completed the Quest Central for Oracle class do not need to take this class.
